

5. All e-Bid must be accompanied by e-Bid Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) in the form of **Demand Draft/RTGS/NEFT**, drawn in favour of Uttarakhand Sahkari Chini Mills Sangh Ltd., Dehradun. The scanned copy of the **e-Bid EMD** must be submitted along with the e-Bid and the original should reach the Federation's office at Dehradun before opening of technical e-Bids. No Interest would be payable on e-Bid (Earnest Money) deposited with the Federation.
6. The e-Bids will be electronically opened in the presence of bidder/contractors's representatives, who choose to attend at the venue, date and time mentioned in the above table. An authority letter of bidder/contractors' representative will be required to be produced.

SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDER/CONTRACTORS (ITB)

(A) THE BID DOCUMENT

1- Cost of e-Bid

- a) The bidder/contractors shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its e-Bid and Uttarakhand Sahkari Chini Mills Sangh Ltd. Dehradun hereinafter referred to as “the Tenderer”, will in no case be responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the e-Bid process.
- b) This Tender document is available on the web site <http://uktenders.gov.in> and www.uttarakhandsugars.com to enable the bidder/contractors to view, download the e-Bid document and submit e-Bids online up to the last date and time mentioned in e-Tender notice/e-Tender document against this e-Tender. The bidder/contractors shall have to pay e-Tender document fee of **Rs. 2,360.00 (GST Inclusive)** through **Demand Draft/RTGS/NEFT** payable in favour of Uttarakhand Sahkari Chini Mills Sangh Ltd. Dehradun. The scanned copy of the Cash Deposit Receipt or **Demand Draft/RTGS/NEFT** must be enclosed along with the e-Bid but the original Demand Draft should reach the Tenderer’s office before opening of the technical e-Bid. This e-Tender document fee of **Rs. 2,360.00 (GST Inclusive)** will be non-refundable.

2- Contents of e-Bid Document

- 2.1 The goods required to be supplied e-Bid procedure and contract terms and conditions are prescribed in the e-Bid document. The e-Bid document includes:

- 2.2- The bidder/contractors is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the e-Bid document. Failure to furnish all information required as per the e-Bid document or submission of e-Bid not responsive to the e-Bid document in every respect will be at the bidder/contractors’s risk and may result in rejection of the said e-Bid.

3- Clarification of e-Bid Document

A prospective bidder/contractors requiring any clarification of the e-Bid document may raise his/her point of clarification through Bid Management Window after successfully login to the e-Procurement website <http://uktenders.gov.in>. The bidder/contractors may seek clarification by posting query in the relevant window after clicking "Seek Clarification" option in the view e-Tender details window for e-Tender which can be selected through my Tender option of e-Bid submission menu. The clarification will be replied back by the Tenderer through the e-Procurement website which can be read by the bidder/contractors through the "Clarification" option under Bid Submission menu. The Tenderer may also respond to clarifications raised by the prospective bidder/contractors on Tenderer's e-mail address uksugars@gmail.com.

4- Amendment of e-Bid Document

- 4.1 At any time prior to the deadline for submission of e-Bid, the Tenderer may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective bidder/contractors, modify the e-Bid document by amendments. Such amendments shall be uploaded on the e-Procurement website <http://uktenders.gov.in> and Purchaser’s web site www.uttarakhandsugars.com through corrigendum and shall form an integral part of e-Bid document. The relevant clauses of the e-Bid document shall be treated as amended accordingly.

- 4.2 It shall be the sole responsibility of the prospective bidder/contractors to check the web site <http://uktenders.gov.in> and www.uttarakhandsugars.com from time to time for any amendment in the e-Tender document. In case of failure to get the amendments, if any, the Tenderer shall not be responsible for it.
- 4.3 In order to allow prospective e-Bidder/contractors a reasonable time to take the amendment into account in preparing their e-Bids, the Tenderer, at his discretion, may extend the deadline for the submission of e-Bids. Such extensions shall be uploaded on the e-Procurement website <http://uktenders.gov.in> and Tenderer's web site www.uttarakhandsugars.com.

(B) PREPARATION OF e-Bid

5 Language of e-Bid

- 5.1 The e-Bid prepared by the bidder/contractors, as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the e-Bid exchanged by the bidder/contractors and the Tenderer shall be written either in English or Hindi language. The correspondence and documents in Hindi must be accompanied by embedded/separate Hindi font files. Only English numerals shall be used in the e-Bid.

6 Documents Constituting the e-Bid

- 6.1 The e-Bid prepared by the bidder/contractors shall comprise the following components:

(a) **Technical e-Bid** - Technical e-Bid will comprise of :

- (i) **Fee Details** – includes copies of e-Tender document processing/Cost and e-Bid Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) furnished in accordance with **ITB Clause 12** in PDF format.
- (ii) **Qualification Details** – includes copies of required documents as per ITB Clauses **10 and 11** in PDF format justifying that the bidder/contractors is qualified to perform the contract if his/her bid is accepted and that the bidder/contractors has financial, technical and Production capability necessary to perform the contract and meets the criteria outlined in the Qualification Requirement and Technical Specification and fulfill all the conditions of the Contract and that the goods and ancillary services to be supplied by the bidder/contractors conform to the e-bid documents and technical specifications.
- (iii) **e-Bid Form** – includes copy of filled in e-Bid Form as per **Section-III(A)** of e-Tender document in PDF format justifying that the bidder/contractors is complying with all the conditions of the Contract and Technical Specifications of the e-Bid Document as no deviation will be acceptable to the Tenderer.
- (iv) **Technical Specification Details** – includes copy of filled in Technical Specifications as per **Section-III(C)** of e-Tender document in PDF format.

(b) **Financial e-Bid** – Financial e-Bid will comprise of :

- (i) **E-Bid Form** – includes copy of filled in e-Bid Form as per **Section-IV (A)** of e-Tender document in PDF format.
- (ii) **Price Schedule/BOQ** – includes **Price Schedule/BOQ in XLS format** to be filled in after downloading from the e-Procurement website for this e-Tender.

7- e-Bid Form

- 7.1 The bidder/contractors/contractors shall complete the e-Bid Form and the appropriate Price Schedule/BOQ furnished in the e-Bid document, including the goods to be supplied, their quantities and prices in the format given in the e-Bid document.

8 e-Bid Price

- 8.1- The bidder/contractors/contractors shall quote separately in the downloaded spread sheet file for the Price of **Renovation of old residential quarters type C, D, E and Dormitory** to be supplied to Mill.
- 8.2 The price of Renovation of old residential quarters type C, D, E and Dormitory inclusive of Basic rate, packing & forwarding, loading & unloading charge, transportation charge and other relevant miscellaneous expenses and Excluding G.S.T.
- 8.3 Price quoted by the Bidder/contractors shall be fixed during the bidder/contractors's performance of the contract and not subject to variation on any account, subject to ITB

Clause 25.1. A e-Bid submitted with an adjustable price quotation unless asked for shall be treated as non-responsive and rejected.

9 e-Bid Currencies

Prices shall be quoted in Indian Rupees only.

10 Documents Establishing bidder/contractors's Qualification

10.1 Pursuant to ITB Clause 6, the bidder/contractors shall furnish, as part of its Technical e-Bid, documents establishing the bidder/contractors's qualification to perform the Contract if its e-Bid is accepted. The documentary evidence should be submitted by the bidder/contractors electronically in the PDF format.

The documentary evidence of bidder/contractors's qualification to perform the Contract if its e-Bid is accepted shall be as per Qualification Requirements specified in Section III (D) of e-tender document.

11 Documents Establishing Goods' Conformity to e-Bid Documents

11.1 Pursuant to ITB Clause 6, the bidder/contractors shall furnish, as part of its e-Bid, documents establishing the conformity to the e-Bid documents of all goods and services which the bidder/contractors proposes to supply under the contract. The documentary evidence should be in the PDF file format.

12 e-Bid Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)

12.1 Pursuant to ITB Clause 6, the bidder/contractors shall furnish, as part of its e-Bid, an e-Bid EMD of Rs. 1,60,000.00 (One Lakh Sixty Thousand Only) in the form of Demand Draft/RTGS/NEFT, in favour of Uttarakhand Sahkari Chini Mills Sangh Ltd. Dehradun. The scanned copy of the e-Bid EMD must be submitted along with the e-Bid and the original should reach the Tenderer's office at Dehradun before opening of technical e-Bid. No interest on EMD will be paid.

12.2 The e-Bid EMD is required to protect the Tenderer against the risk of bidder/contractors's conduct which would warrant the Earnest Money's forfeiture, pursuant to ITB Clause 12.7.

12.3 The e-Bid EMD shall be in Indian Rupees and shall be in the following forms only:

A Demand Draft/RTGS/NEFT payable in favour of Uttarakhand Sahkari Chini Mills Sangh Ltd. Dehradun. Bidder/contractors may submit the bid EMD of the above amount in the form of Bank Draft payable in favour of Uttarakhand Sahkari Chini Mills Sangh Ltd. at Dehradun.

12.4 Any e-Bid not secured in accordance with ITB Clauses 12.1 and 12.3 above shall be treated as non-responsive and rejected by the Tenderer.

12.5 Unsuccessful bidder/contractors's e-Bid EMD will be returned upon the written request through cheque as promptly as possible.

12.6 The successful bidder/contractors's e-Bid EMD will be converted into security and in addition to EMD equal amount or decided by the Purchase Committee at the time of negotiation and before issue the rate contract, will be deposited with Federation pursuant to ITB Clause 28 and furnishing the performance security pursuant to ITB Clause 29.

12.7 The e-Bid EMD may be forfeited:

(a) if a bidder/contractors (i) withdraws its e-Bid during the period of e-Bid validity specified by the Bidder/contractors on the e-Bid Form; or (ii) does not accept the correction of errors pursuant to ITB Clause 22.2; or (iii) modifies its e-Bid price during the period of e-Bid validity specified by the Bidder/contractors on the e-Bid form or

(b) in case of a successful bidder/contractors, if the bidder/contractors fails:

(i) To sign the contract with the Tenderer in accordance with ITB Clause 28 or

(ii) To furnish performance security in accordance to ITB Clause 29.

13 Period of Validity of e-Bid

13.1 e-Bid shall remain valid upto 90 days. An e-bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected by the Tenderer as non responsive.

13.2 In exceptional circumstances the Tenderer may solicit the bidder/contractors consent to an extension of the period of e-bid validity. The request and the response thereto shall be made in

writing. A bidder/contractors may refuse the request without forfeiting its e-bid security. A bidder/contractors granting the request will not be required nor permitted to modify its e-bid.

14. Format and Signing of e-Bid

14.1- The bidder/contractors shall prepare one electronic copy each of the Technical e-Bid and Financial e-Bid separately.

14.2- The e-Bid document shall be digitally signed, at the time of uploading, by the bidder/contractors or a person or persons duly authorized to bind the bidder/contractors to the Contract. The later authorization shall be indicated by a scanned copy of written power-of-attorney accompanying the e-Bid. All the pages/documents of the e-Bid that are to be uploaded shall be digitally signed by the person authorized to sign the e-Bid.

15. Submission of e-Bid

The Bid Submission module of e-Procurement website <http://uktenders.gov.in> enables the bidder/contractors to submit the e-Bid online in response to this e-Tender published by the Tenderer. Bid Submission can be done only from the Bid Submission start date and time till the Bid Submission end date and time given in the e-Tender. Bidder/contractors should start the Bid Submission process well in advance so that they can submit their e-Bid in time. The bidder/contractors should submit their e-Bid considering the server time displayed in the e-Procurement website. This server time is the time by which the e-Bid submission activity will be allowed till the permissible time on the last/end date of submission indicated in the e-Tender schedule. Once the e-Bid submission date and time is over, the bidder/contractors cannot submit their e-Bid. For delay in submission of e-Bid due to any reasons, the bidder/contractors shall only be held responsible.

The bidder/contractors have to follow the following instructions for submission of their e-Bid:

15.1 For participating in e-Bid through the e-Tendering system, it is necessary for the bidder/contractors to be the registered users of the e-Procurement website <http://uktenders.gov.in>. The bidder/contractors must obtain a User Login Id and Password by registering themselves with **uktenders.gov.in** if they have not done so previously for registration. Refer to details given in Invitation for **e-Bid Clause 11**. (If bidder/contractors have any problem regarding registration at uktenders.gov.in please contact to Mr. Suman Uniyal – 80065-50807.

15.2 In addition to the normal registration, the bidder/contractors has to register with his/her **Digital Signature Certificate (DSC)** in the e-Tendering system and subsequently he/she will be allowed to carry out his/her e-Bid submission activities. Registering the Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) is a one time activity. Before proceeding to register his/her DSC, the bidder/contractors should first log on to the e-Tendering system using the User Login option on the home page with the Login Id and Password with which he/ she has registered as per clause 15.1 above.

For successful registration of DSC on e-Procurement website <http://uktenders.gov.in> the bidder/contractors must ensure that he/she should possess Class-2/ Class-3 DSC issued by any certifying authorities approved by Controller of Certifying Authorities, Government of India, as the e-Procurement website <http://uktenders.gov.in> is presently accepting DSCs issued by these authorities only. The bidder/contractors can obtain User Login Id and perform DSC registration exercise as described in clauses 15.1 and 15.2 above even before e-Bid submission date starts. The Tenderer shall not be held responsible if the bidder/contractors tries to submit his/her e-Bid at the last moment before end date of submission but could not submit due to DSC registration problem.

15.3 The bidder/contractors can search for active Tenders through "Search Active Tenders" link, select a Tender in which he/she is interested in and then move it to 'My Tenders' folder using the options available in the e-Bid Submission menu. After selecting and viewing the Tender, for which the bidder/contractors intends to e-Bid, from "My Tenders" folder, the bidder/contractors can place his/her e-Bid by clicking "Pay Offline" option available at the end of the view Tender details form. Before this, the bidder/contractors should download the e-Tender document and Price Schedule/Bill of Quantity (BOQ) and study them carefully. The

bidder/contractors should keep all the documents ready as per the requirements of e-Tender document in the PDF format except the Price Schedule/Bill of Quantity (BOQ) which should be in the XLS format (Excel sheet).

- 5.4 After clicking the 'Pay Offline' option, the bidder/contractors will be redirected to the Terms and Conditions page. The bidder/contractors should read the Terms & Conditions before proceeding to fill in the Tender Fee and EMD offline payment details. After entering and saving the Tender Fee and EMD details, the bidder/contractors should click "Encrypt & Upload" option given in the offline payment details form so that "Bid Document Preparation and Submission" window appears to upload the documents as per Technical (Fee details, Qualification details, e-Bid Form and Technical Specification details) and financial (e-Bid Form and Price Schedule/BOQ) schedules/packets given in the Tender details. The details of the Demand Draft or any other accepted instrument which is to be physically sent in original before opening of technical e-Bid, should tally with the details available in the scanned copy and the data entered during e-Bid submission time otherwise the e-Bid submitted will not be accepted.
- 15.5 Next the bidder/contractors should upload the Technical e-Bid documents for Fee details (e-Tender fee and EMD), Qualification details as per "ITB Clause 10 or 21", e-Bid Form as per "Section-III(A)" and Technical Specification details as per "Section-III(C):Technical Specifications" and Financial e-Bid documents as per "Section-IV(A):e-Bid Form" and "Section-IV(B):Price Schedule/BOQ" of e-Tender document. Before uploading, the bidder/contractors has to select the relevant Digital Signature Certificate. He may be prompted to enter the Digital Signature Certificate password, if necessary. For uploading, the bidder/contractors should click "Browse" button against each document label in Technical and Financial schedules/packets and then upload the relevant PDF/XLS files already prepared and stored in the bidder/contractors's computer. The required documents for each document label of Technical (Fee details, Qualification details, e-Bid Form and Technical Specification details) and financial (e-Bid Form and Price Schedule/BOQ) schedules/packets can be clubbed together to make single different files for each label.
- 15.6 The bidder/contractors should click "Encrypt" next for successfully encrypting and uploading of required documents. During the above process, the e-Bid documents are digitally signed using the DSC of the bidder/contractors and then the documents are encrypted/locked electronically with the DSC's of the bid openers to ensure that the e-Bid documents are protected, stored and opened by concerned bid openers only.

- 15.8 Tenderer reserves the right to cancel any or all e-Bids without assigning any reason.
- 16- Deadline for Submission of e-Bid**
- 16.1 e-Bid (Technical and financial) must be submitted by the bidder/contractors at e-Procurement website <http://uktenders.gov.in> not later than the time 06:00 P.M. on 26.02.2026 (as the server time displayed in the e-Procurement website).
- 16.2 The Tenderer may, at its discretion, extend this deadline for submission of e-Bid by amending the e-Bid document in accordance with ITB Clause 4, in which case all rights and obligations of the Tenderer and bidder/contractors previously subject to the deadline will thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended.

17 Late e-Bid

- 17.1 The server time indicated in the Bid Management window on the e-Procurement website <http://uktenders.gov.in> will be the time by which the e-Bid submission activity will be allowed till the permissible date and time scheduled in the e-Tender. Once the e-Bid submission date and time is over, the bidder/contractors cannot submit his/her e-Bid. Bidder/contractors has to start the Bid Submission well in advance so that the submission process passes off smoothly. The bidder/contractors will only be held responsible if his/her e-Bid is not submitted in time due to any of his/her problems/faults, for whatsoever reason, during e-Bid submission process.

18 Withdrawal and Resubmission of e-Bid

- 18.1 At any point of time, a bidder/contractors can withdraw his/her e-Bid submitted online before the bid submission end date and time. (C) e-Bid OPENING AND EVALUATION OF e-Bid

19(A) Opening of Technical e-Bid by the Tenderer

- 19.A.1 The Tenderer will open all technical e-Bids, in the presence of bidder/contractors' representatives who choose to attend at **10:30 AM on 27.02.2026** at Uttarakhand Sahkari Chini Mills Sangh Ltd., Near Railway Crossing Badripur Road, Jogiwala, Dehradun. The bidder/contractors's representatives who are present shall sign a register evidencing their attendance. In the event of the specified date of e-Bid opening being declared a holiday for the Tenderer, the e-Bids shall be opened at the appointed time and place on the next working day.
- 19.A.2 The bidder/contractors's names and the presence or absence of requisite e-Bid EMD and such other details as the Tenderer at its discretion may consider appropriate, will be announced at the opening. The name of such bidder/contractors not meeting the Technical Specifications and qualification requirement shall be notified subsequently.
- 19.A.3 The Tenderer will prepare minutes of the e-Bid opening.

19.A.4 Federation reserves the right to postpone the date and time of opening of technical and financial e-bids in unavoidable circumstances and all the bidder/contractors will be informed.

19(B) Opening of Financial e-Bid

19.B.1 After evaluation of technical e-Bid, the Tenderer shall notify those bidder/contractors whose technical e-Bids were considered non-responsive to the Conditions of the Contract and not meeting the technical specifications and Qualification Requirements indicating that their financial e-Bids will not be opened. The Tenderer will simultaneously notify the bidder/contractors, whose technical e-Bids were considered acceptable to the Tenderer. The notification may be sent by letter, fax or by e-mail.

19.B.2 The financial e-Bids of technically qualified bidder/contractors shall be opened on **27.02.2026 at 03:00 P.M.** in the presence of bidder/contractors who choose to attend. The name of bidder/contractors, Unit Price quoted for various items etc will be announced at the meeting.

19.B.3 The Tenderer will prepare the minutes of the e-Bid opening.

20 Clarification of e-Bid

20.1 During evaluation of e-Bid, the Tenderer may, at its discretion, ask the bidder/contractors for a clarification of his/her e-Bid. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing.

21 Evaluation of technical e-Bid and Evaluation Criteria

The Tenderer will examine the e-Bid to determine whether they are complete, whether they meet all the conditions of the Contract, whether required e-Tender fee, e-Bid EMD and other required documents have been furnished, whether the documents have been properly digitally signed, and whether the e-Bids are generally in order. Any e-Bid or e-Bids not fulfilling these requirements shall be rejected.

The bidder/contractors shall submit the scanned copies of following as documentary proof for evaluation of their technical e-Bids:-

21.1 The bidder/contractors has to submit the minimum 03 (Three) work order of last three year for the Civil construction work in Cooperative/Corporation/Private Sugar Mill and last 02 (Two) years performance certificates.

OR

The bidder/contractors must be registered with any Govt. Deptt i.e. PWD, RWD, Bridcul, Irrigation etc., for which it will be mandatory to attach the relevant empanelment certificate.

21.2 The bidder/contractors shall submit the copies of detail of e-tender & emd fees.

21.3 The bidder/contractors submit the copy of Registration certificate of GST (copy self attested).

21.4 The bidder/contractors should submit the detail of last three years' turnover duly certified by Chartered Accountant.

21.5 The average turnover of construction works of the tenderer in the last 05 years must be 50 percent of the cost of the tender.

21.6 The tenderer must have experience of executing at least one work costing at least 33% of the estimated cost of the tender as main contractor in the last 05 years.

21.7 The bidder/contractors shall submit the copies of the last submitted Income Tax Return & PAN card (copy self attested).

21.8 The bidder/contractors shall submit the documentary proof of the Status of the company along with names of Directors/Partners/Proprietor along with documents.

21.9 The e-Bids found to be not responsive to and not fulfilling all the conditions of the contract and not meeting Technical Specifications and Qualification Requirements to the satisfaction of Tenderer shall be rejected and may not be subsequently made responsive by the bidder/contractors by correction of the non-conformity. The e-Bids of bidder/contractors mentioning any of their conditions which are not mentioned in the e-tender document or are not in conformity with the conditions of the contract shall be rejected.

21.10 It shall be the discretion of the Tenderer to decide as to whether an e-Bid fulfils the evaluation criterion mentioned in this e-tender or not.

21.11 The bidder/contractors are advised not to mix financial bid documents with the PDF documents submitted for technical bid. The e-Bids of the bidder/contractors having financial bid document in the technical bid will out rightly be rejected.

22 Financial Evaluation and Comparison of e-Bid

- 22.1 The Tenderer will evaluate and compare the financial rates of individual items quoted in the price schedule/BOQ of e-Bids of those bidder/contractors whose technical e-Bids are found responsive as per the conditions of the e-Tender only for those items of the bidder/contractors which have been technically accepted by the Tenderer.
- 22.2 No additional payments shall be made for completion of any contractual obligation beyond the quoted prices. If the supplier does not accept the correction of errors if any, its e-Bid shall be rejected and its e-Bid EMD may be forfeited.
- 22.3 No weightage/preference shall be given to the bidder/contractors quoting any higher technical specifications against the technical specifications of the items asked in the e-tender.
- 22.4 The Tenderer evaluation of financial bid shall be based on basic rate/price quoted by the Bidder/contractors. The price of incidental services freight, insurance and other cost within India incidental to the delivery goods to their final destination shall be as mentioned in para 8.2 of ITB
- 22.5 The Financial Bids will be opened by Tender Evaluation Committee [TEC] in the presence of Bidder/contractors' representatives (only one) who choose to attend the Financial Bid opening on date and time to be communicated to all the technically qualified Bidder/contractors. The Bidder/contractors's representatives who are present shall sign a register evidencing their attendance. The name of Bidder/contractors, Bid Prices etc. shall be announced at the meeting. The commercial quotes of the Lowest Bidder/contractors (L-1) shall be notified as L-1. The quantity offered by the L-1 shall be first taken into consideration.
- a) In case L-1 offers to supply the complete order quantity and is assessed to have the adequate capacity to supply the complete order quantity as per the delivery schedule by the tender evaluation committee, then L-1 shall be contacted to execute the complete supply order.
- b) In case L-1 backs out, the tender shall be cancelled & Bids shall be invited again L-1 shall however be blacklisted from participating in any future bidding and are liable for legal action taken by UTTARHAND SUGARS.

23 Contacting the Tenderer

- 23.1 Subject to **ITB Clause 20**, no bidder/contractors shall contact the Tenderer on any matter relating to his/her e-Bid, from the time of the e-Bid opening to the time the Contract is awarded. If the bidder/contractors wishes to bring additional information to the notice of the Tenderer, he/she can do so in writing.
- 23.2 Any effort by a bidder/contractors to influence the Tenderer in its decisions on e-Bid evaluation, e-Bid comparison or contract award may result in rejection of the bidder/contractors's e-Bid.

(D) AWARD OF CONTRACT

24. Award Criteria

- 24.1 The Tenderer will determine to its satisfaction whether the bidder/contractors that is selected as having submitted the lowest rate (L-1) evaluated responsive bid meets the criteria specified in ITB clause 10.2 and is qualified to perform the contract satisfactorily.
- 24.2 The Subject to ITB Clause 26 the Federation will award the contract to the Lowest bidder/contractors (L-1) successfully bidder/contractors whose bid has been determined to be responsive to all the conditions of the contract and meeting the technical specification and qualification requirement of bidding document.

25 Tenderer's right to vary Quantities at the Time of Award

- 25.1 The Tenderer reserves the right at the time of contract award to increase or decrease the quantity of goods and services originally specified in the schedule of requirements without any change in unit price or other terms & conditions depending upon the requirement of end customer. The Tenderer may also increase/decrease the quantity even after award of contract upto the validity period of e-bid.
- 25.2 If any taxes/duties are increased/ decreased by the Government during the contract period, the same shall be adjusted mutually after submitting the proof by the successful bidder/contractors to the Tenderer.

26 Tenderer's right to accept any e-bid and to reject any or all e-bids.

26.1 The Tenderer reserves the right to accept or reject any e-bid and to annul the e-bid process and reject all e-bids at any time prior to contract award without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder/contractors/bidder/contractors.

27 Notification of Award

27.1 The Tenderer will notify the successful bidder/contractors in writing by letter/e-mail/fax, that its e-Bid has been accepted. Normally it will be informed within 30 days after opening e-commercial/financial bid, except in unavoidable circumstances.

27.2 The notification of award will constitute the formation of the Contract.

28 Signing of Contract

At the same time as the purchase notifies the successful bidder/contractors that its e-bid has been accepted the Tenderer will inform the bidder/contractors accordingly.

29 Performance/Work Security

Successful bidder/contractors to deposit 5% security on the form of Bank guarantee/neft/rtgs of the total order value in the name of Uttarakhand Sahkari chini mills sangh limited, as work completion security within 15 (Fifteen) days from the date of issuance of work order from the federation office. No interest shall be paid on the security deposit. Whose validity should be till 31th March 2027. Which will be refunded after the receiving satisfactory report and no dues information of the successful bidder/contractors from the sugar mills, if any liability of the successful bidder/contractors arises in the sugar mill sitarganj then after its adjustment, it will be returned within one month. The earnest money amount of Rs. 1,60,000.00 deposited by the successful bidder/contractors while participating in e-tendering process will be refunded after receipt of 05% bank guarantee in the Federation office and after verification of its authenticity from the bank.

4. Section II- Conditions of E-Tender /Contract(CC)

1. Price

4. Payment Terms

5. Sanctity

6. Penalty

There will be late penalty of 01% of total work order value in case of delayed work completion upto 01 week. In case the work completion delayed more than 03 weeks concerned firm/contractors will be 02 years debar and security money forfeited.

7. Arbitration

- 7.1 Any dispute/difference arising between the parties hereto relating to any matter out of or concerned with this work order, such dispute or difference shall be referred to the award of the Sole Arbitrator who shall be The Administrator, Uttarakhand Sugars, Dehradun under this work order. The venue of the Arbitration in all cases shall be Dehradun and the proceedings, documents and award shall be in English Language.
- 7.2 In the event of Sole Arbitrator dying, neglecting or refusing to act, or resigning or being unable to act for any reason or his award being set aside by the Court, for any reason, it shall be lawful for the Authority appointing the Arbitrator to appoint another arbitrator in place of the outgoing arbitrator in the manner aforesaid.
- 7.3 Upon every and any such reference, the assessment of the cost of reference and the award respectively shall be at the discretion of the arbitrator.
- 7.4 The arbitrator may from time to time, with the consent of all the parties to the work order, enhance the time for declaring the award.
- 7.5 The arbitrator shall make the award specifying the reasons in writing.
- 7.6 Work under the work order, if reasonably possible, may continue, during the arbitration proceedings and no payments due or payable by the Tenderer shall be withheld on account of such proceedings.
- 7.7 In the Clause the Authority to appoint the arbitrator, include, if there is no such Authority, the officer, who is, for the time being discharging the function or otherwise.
8. In case of non compliance of the conditions of the contract the Managing Director of Federation shall have the power to rescind, cancel and annul the contract, between the Tenderer and the contractor apart from black-listing the contractor, and in that event, the sum deposited towards security shall be forfeited and the contractor shall be further liable to pay actual amount of loss and damages as provided in Indian Contract Act to the extent the same exceeds the security money.
9. In case of any dispute between the contractor and Tenderer the Hon'ble High Court of judicature at Nainital and Courts sub-ordinate there to of the District in which the mill is situated shall alone have jurisdiction to the exclusion of all other courts.
10. In complete tender or those without the prescribed tender and emd fees may be rejected.
11. The Tenderer reserves the right to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason. The Tenderer also reserves the right to amend or altogether change the terms & conditions in the overall interest of the Organization before finalization of the work order.
12. The bidder/contractors should submit affidavit for in relation to the E-Tender Form Debar and integrity pact (IP) as per attach Performa on Rs. 100/- Non judicial stamp paper to be uploaded E Tender and hardcopy to be sent through courier/by post.
13. The Bidder/contractors shall upload all required documents strictly at the time of filling e- Tender. No physical document will be accepted at any case during the Tender Process.
14. If required L-1 bidder/contractors will be called for necessary negotiation afterwards.
15. Bidder/contractors/Supplier himself or his representative is not required to present at the time of technical/financial bid opening. Complete tendering process will be conducted faceless.
16. If in any case any bidder/contractors/supplier impose undue influence (Convincing) in that case the concerned bidder/contractors/supplier will be debarred for next 02 years to participate in any tender process of Federation.
17. Any bidder/Supplier are disputed in court not participate in Federation tender.

- 1- The work must be completely furnished to the entire satisfaction of the Engineer-in-charge of the factory within the specified four months period as above tender documents from the date of receipt of order to commence work.
- 2- The tenderers are supposed to know the standard terms and conditions of contract for various types of work and the relevant Indian standard specifications, code of practice and CPWD (D.S.R.) specifications, which shall be followed.
- 3- The tender must be submitted on prescribed form issued by this office the tenderers shall quote his percentage tender rate both in figure and words.
- 4- The rates are to be quoted only on basis of bill of quantity provided in the tender documents. Rate as quoted with any additional conditions shall not be considered and such offers shall be rejected.
- 5- In case of firm, the tender must be signed by the each partner of any partner holding the power of Attorney of behalf of firm. A copy of power partner holding the power of attorney attested by gazetted officer must be accompanied with tender.
- 6- If the contractor fails to complete the work either in accordance with the construction programme or by the schedule date of completion of whole of the work or the time extended by the mill society he shall without demur or objection pay liquidated damages equal to 15% of the cost of work, that remains incomplete for every week or part there of beyond the agreed specified date of completion till the date of works remained in complete so however, that the total amount of such liquidated damages shall not exceed 5% of the total value of the contract.
- 7- The quantities are given in the bill of quantity are subjected to actual execution of the work. The contractor shall be bound to execute the quantities as per mill requirements on the rates provided in the bill of quantity.
- 8- All bills would be liable to deductions of total security amount 05% the amount shall be refunded after six months if the work is satisfactory.
- 9- The tendered rates shall include all quarrying, royalty, testing, screens, tools and plants, railway freights, carriage of materials and all taxes. The contractor's rate will be deemed for the complete items in all respect.
- 10- Income tax shall be deducted from all the payments made to the contractor and GST shall be paid to contractor by the mill society as per rule.
- 11- **EXTRA ITEMS :-**
In case the mill society instructs the contractor to execute any additional item of work not included in the bill of quantities, the rate of such additional/substituted work shall be worked out in accordance with the following provisions in their respective order.
 - (a) The rates will be derived from the rates for similar type of work or item analogues to the item concerned plus or minus the tendered percentage.
 - (b) Analysed on the basis of standard CPWD (D.S.R.) detailed analysis of rates after adopting the rates of materials and labour sanctioned by CPWD (D.S.R.) on the date of execution of the work. The tendered percentage above or below shall be paid or deducted from the rates so derived.
 - (c) Analysed on the basis of standard detailed analysis of CPWD (D.S.R.) after adopting current market rates of labour and materials, if CPWD (D.S.R.) sanctioned rates are not available however the tendered percentage above or below shall be paid or deducted for the items analysed under this clause.
 - (d) On the basis of market rates or actual cost of execution plus 10% contractor's profit.

- 12- Extra items prepared as mentioned in items no. 11 above shall be got technically sanctioned from civil engineer of factory before executing the same at site. The AE. (Civil) shall technically check the extra items and accord technical sanction restricting the expenditure within the budgetary allotment.
- 13- For variation of quantities against all the items of bill of quantities a variation statement shall be prepared by the civil Engineer of factory and get technical approval from mill authority The mill authority after technically checking the variation statement, shall accord technical sanction subject to restriction of expenditure within the budgetary allotment if the amount of work done increases the budgetary allotment, then the matter shall be forwarded to the Managing Director, Uk sugars for administrative approval.
- 14- The samples of materials (Supplied by the contractor) to be used in work shall be got approved from the constituted committee materials not confirmed to the approved samples shall be rejected Testing of different materials in respect there of shall be entertained. Testing of different materials as per procedure laid in relevant up-to-date I.S. standards shall be carried out at the cost of the contractor as and when instructed by the constituted committee.
- 15- The contractor will have to get all his workers insured. The contractor will have to submit one copy of this insurance to the security department and one copy to the civil department.




